

# **Tom Bean Police Department**

## **Weapons and Ammunition Specifications**

### **I. Sidearm**

#### **A. Duty Firearm**

1. Officer supplied semi-automatic pistol

Recommended caliber: .9mm

Authorized manufacturers: Sig Sauer, Glock, Heckler & Koch, Smith & Wesson, Beretta, FNH USA, Browning, Ruger, Colt, Kimber, Springfield Armory, Wilson Combat, & Para Ordinance. Other manufacturers may be authorized by the Chief of Police.

Authorized alternative calibers: .40 Cal, .45 ACP, 5.7x28 & .357 Sig. Other calibers may be authorized by the Chief of Police.

2. Officers may not deploy a revolver as a primary (duty carry) weapon.

#### **B. Secondary Firearm / Off-Duty Firearm**

1. The secondary firearm / off-duty firearm may be a revolver or semi-automatic pistol in caliber .380 ACP at a minimum and .45 ACP at a maximum.

### **II. Shotgun**

- #### **A.**
- A pump action 12-gauge shotgun with buttstock. Without buttstock requires approval of the Chief of Police.

Recommended manufacturer: Mossberg

Authorized alternative manufacturers: Remington, Winchester, Beretta, or Benelli

### **III. Rifle**

- #### **A.**
- An M4 type / style semi-automatic .223 / 5.56 rifle with buttstock.

Recommended manufacturer: Colt

Authorized alternative manufacturers: Armalite, Barrett, Bushmaster, Smith & Wesson, Heckler & Koch, Ruger, Sig Sauer, FNH USA, Knights Armament, Springfield, & DPMS.

Alternative type .223 / 5.56 rifles such as the IWI Tavor B16, or FNH SCAR 16 may be carried with prior approval from the Chief of Police. Alternative type rifles should be capable of accepting a standard AR-15 / M16 type magazine.

IV. Pistol Caliber Carbine

- A. Sig Sauer MPX, Heckler & Koch MP5 or USC / UMP variants.
- B. Other pistol caliber carbines may be authorized by the Chief of Police.

V. NFA Weapons

- A. Fully-automatic firearms, short barrel rifles & shotguns, silencers or suppressors regulated by the National Firearms Act of 1934 and / or subsequent amendments may be authorized only for those employees who are qualified with and have prior approval for such weapons.
- B. The Chief of Police will authorize the use of registered NFA weapons on a case-by-case basis.

VI. Weapon Accessories

- A. The following handgun / long gun weaponlight products are approved for duty use:
  - 1. Surefire, Streamlight, or Steiner Optics
- B. The following rifle optics products are approved for duty use:
  - 1. Trijicon, Aimpoint, Sig Sauer, Steiner Optics, or Eotech
- C. The following rail system products are approved for duty use:
  - 1. Yankee Hill Machine, Bravo Company, Daniel Defense, Knights Armament.
- D. The following vertical foregrip products are approved for duty use:
  - 1. Tango Down, Bravo Company, Magpul, Tapco, or Troy Industries

VII. Ammunition

- A. Sidearm
  - 1. Duty Ammunition
    - a) Department-issued Speer .9mm 147 GR Gold Dot G2 ammunition.

- b) Officers using alternative caliber weapons are required to supply their own duty ammunition. Alternative caliber duty ammunition must be Speer "Gold Dot" series.

## 2. Off-Duty Ammunition

- a) Ammunition utilizing jacketed, or semi-jacketed hollow cavity bullets from the following manufacturers is approved for secondary or off-duty use by sworn personnel.
  - (1) CCI Speer
  - (2) Federal
  - (3) Remington
  - (4) Winchester
- b) The following ammunition is prohibited:
  - (1) Explosive, poisonous, or toxic rounds
  - (2) Tracer or incendiary rounds
  - (3) Flechette rounds
  - (4) Armor piercing or Teflon coated rounds
  - (5) Glaser or any pre-fragmented rounds

## B. Shotgun

- 1. Department-issued 00 Buckshot – 9 or 12 count – Remington, Federal, or Winchester
- 2. Department-issued 000 Buckshot – 8 count – Remington, Federal, or Winchester

## C. Rifle

- 1. Department-issued Federal .223/5.56 55 GR ammunition.

D. Less Lethal Firearms / Ammunition

- a) At no time will less lethal ammunition be loaded into the same weapon that standard duty or target ammunition is used in. Less lethal shotguns shall be used exclusively for such purpose and shall be plainly identified as such by an orange colored stock and trim.

VIII. Baton

- A. Officer supplied ASP telescoping baton

IX. O.C. Spray

- A. Officer supplied 10% Oleoresin Capsicum formula 1.47 ounces minimum up to 12 ounces or equivalent.

X. Conducted Electrical Weapon (CEW)

- A. Department-issued AXON TASER CEW.
