

RESOLUTION 2018-12

A RESOLUTION HEREBY DECLARING AUTUMN NIGHTS AS AN EVENT SERVING A PUBLIC PURPOSE AND ACCEPTING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF TEXAS, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SEGMENT OF THE STATE RIGHT-OF-WAY BUSINESS FM 902 AT THE INTERSECTION OF FM 2729-FM 902 AND ENDING AT STATE HIGHWAY 11.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Tom Bean declares Autumn Nights on October 13, 2018, to be an event serving a public purpose, and

WHEREAS, the state owns and operates a system of highways for public use and benefit, including a segment of FM 902 from the intersection of FM 2729/FM 902 to State Highway 11

WHEREAS, the City of Tom Bean is requesting the temporary closure of a segment of FM 902 from the intersection of FM 2729/FM 902 to State Highway 11 for the purpose of the Autumn Nights event, and

WHEREAS, the City of Tom Bean authorizes the temporary closure of a segment of city street located at the 100 block of East Garner Street for the purpose of the Autumn Nights event, and

WHEREAS, the City of Tom Bean authorizes the temporary closure of a segment of city street located at the 100 block of East King Street for the purpose of the Autumn Nights event, and

WHEREAS, the City of Tom Bean authorizes the temporary closure of a segment of city street located at the 100 block of South Britton Street for the purpose of the Autumn Nights event, and

WHEREAS, the state in recognition of the public purpose of the event, wishes to cooperate with the city so long as the safety and convenience of the traveling public is ensured and that the closure of the state's right-of-way will be performed within the state requirements, now, therefore, be it resolved by; the City of Tom Bean, Texas:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOM BEAN AUTHORIZES THE CITY TO ENTER INTO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SEGMENT OF FM 902 FROM THE INTERSECTION OF FM 2729/FM 902 TO STATE HIGHWAY 11 FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTUMN NIGHTS EVENT ON OCTOBER 13, 2018.
